

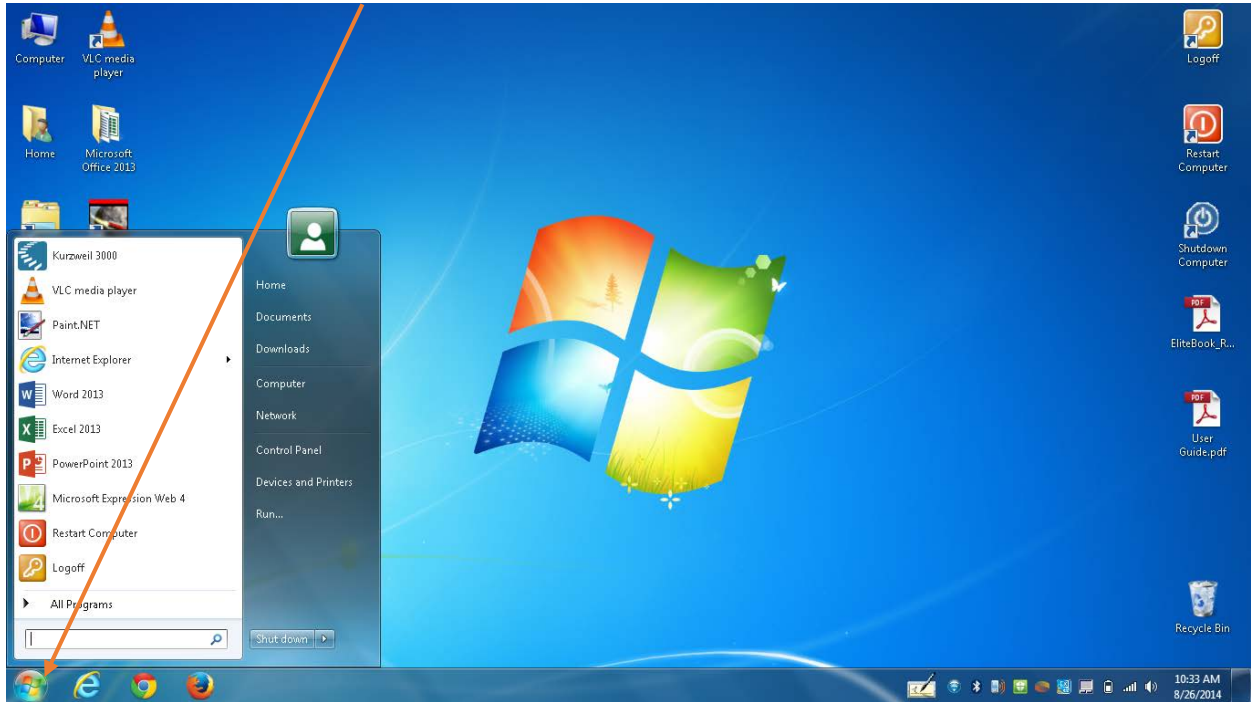

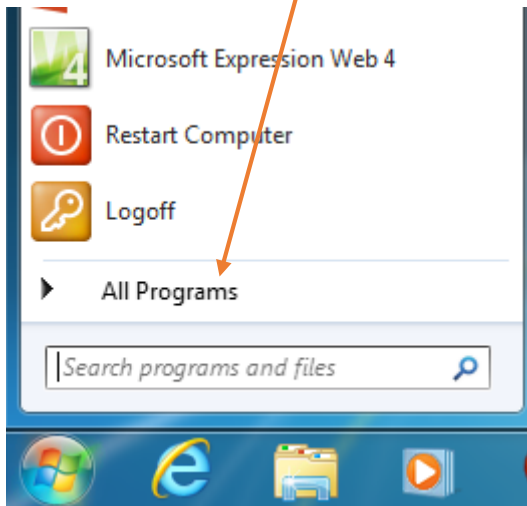
## Windows Movie Maker

2. Click on All Programs

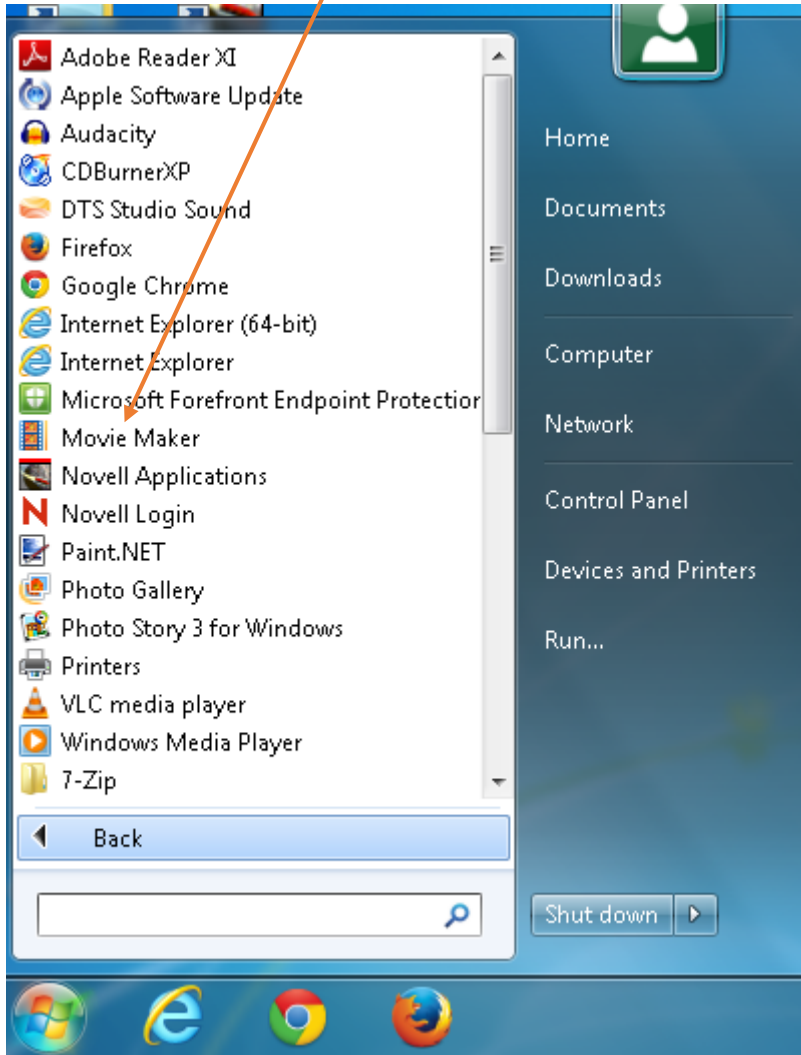

4. Click Webcam video

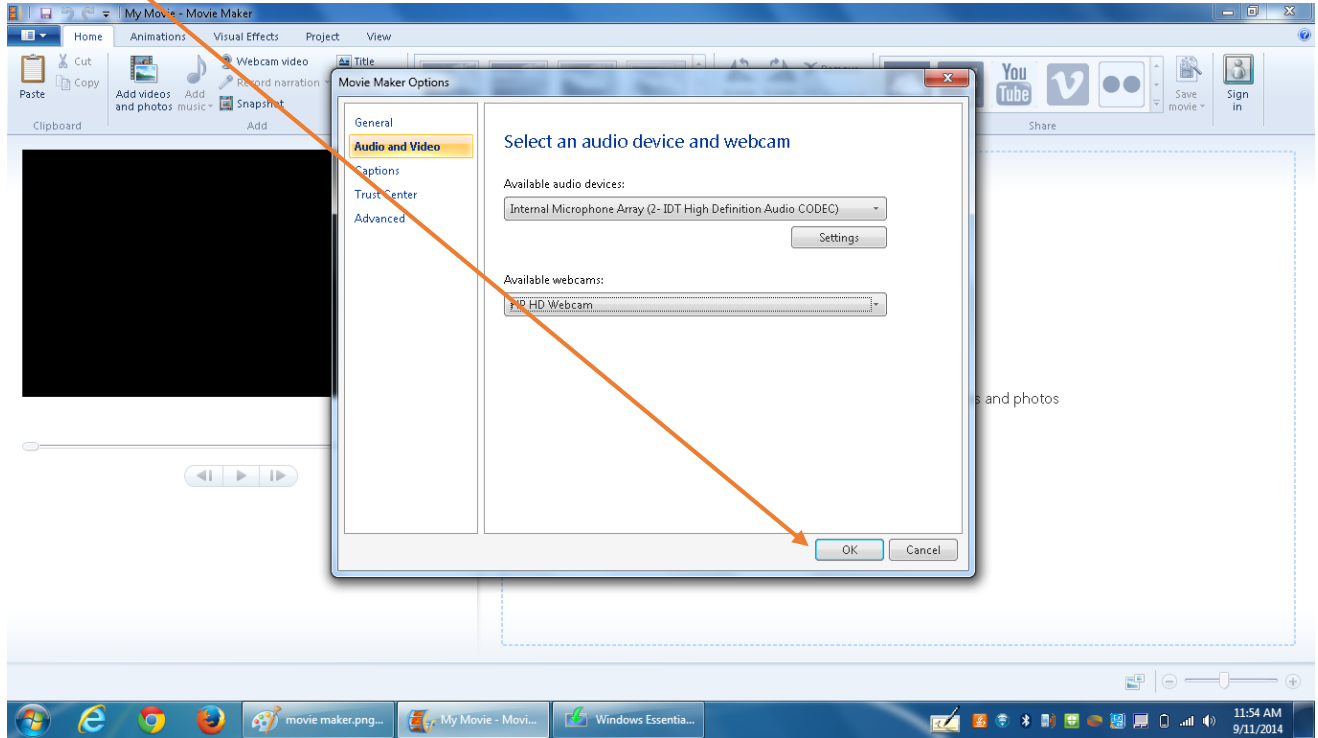

Click Ok

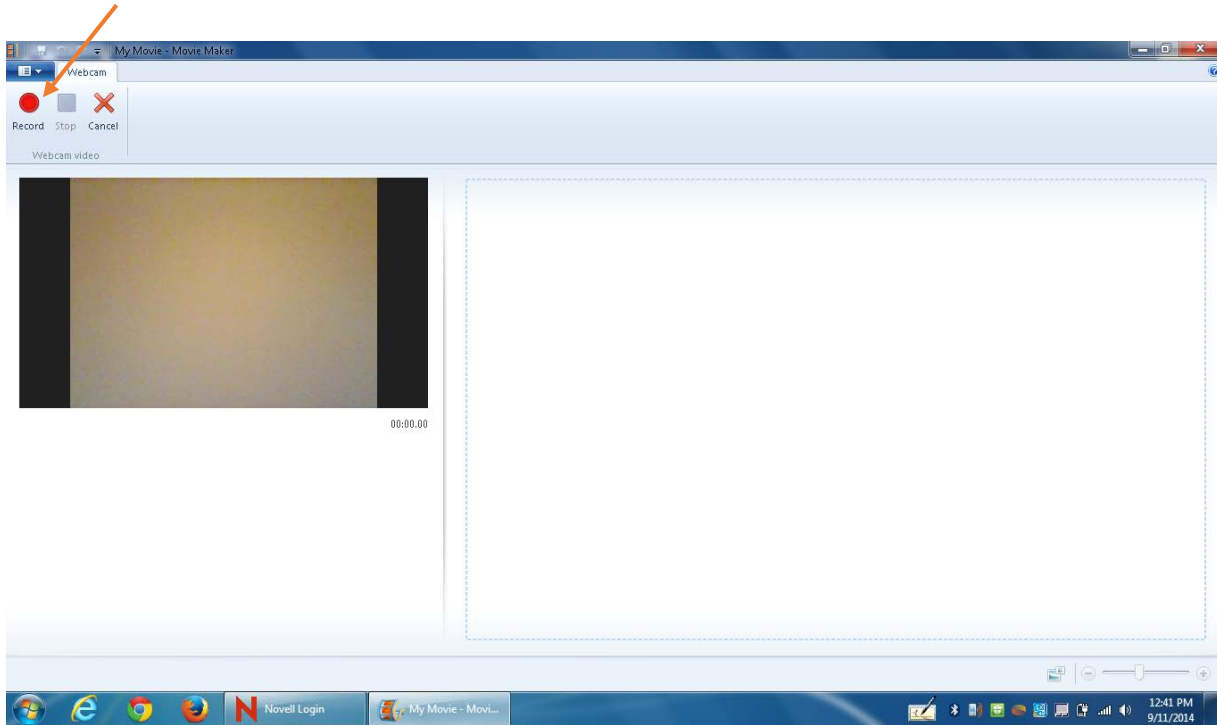




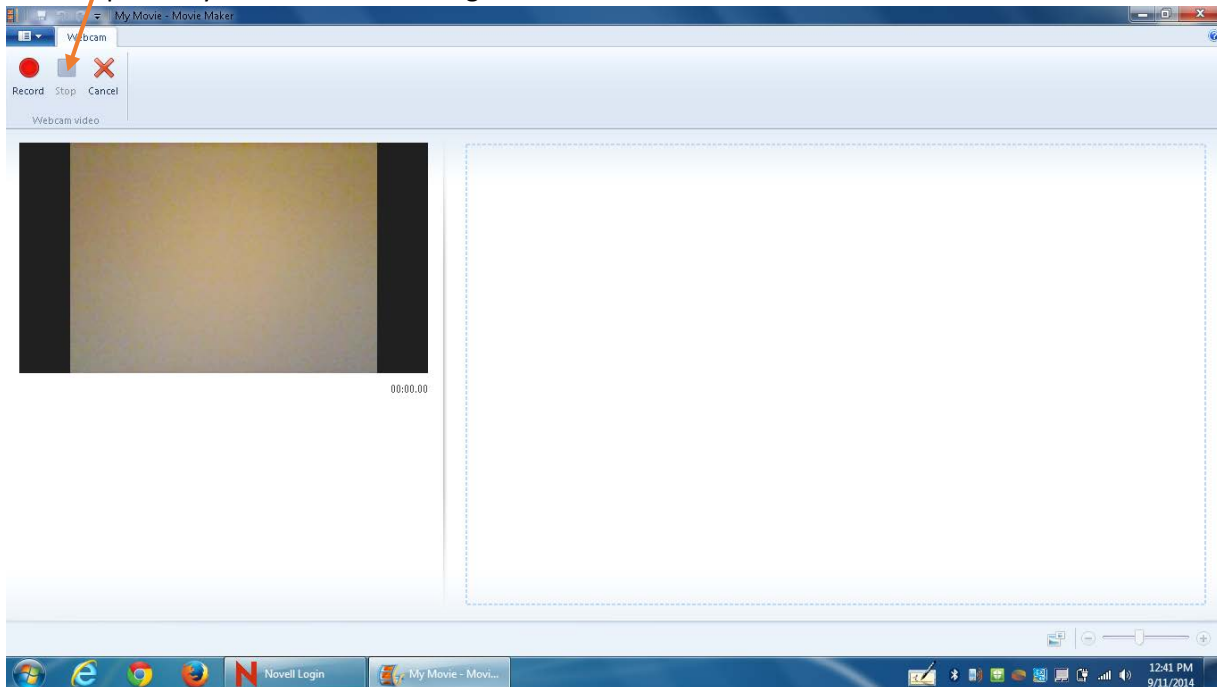
